On October 26, 2017, Alpine Legal Services in conjunction with the Access to Justice Committee of the 9th Judicial District, held a Family Law Resource Day. Again, this was a well-attended event at which people who are going through a divorce/allocation of parental responsibilities case were able to get free mediation, parenting classes, assistance in filling out forms, as well as free consultations with attorneys. Nine different attorneys donated a collective 27 hours of their time to assist by being available to answer legal questions. In just one day, our local bar members donated the equivalent of \$8,100 in attorney hours (27 hours x \$300/hour) to helping those who otherwise could not afford an attorney.

I am so grateful to live in such a wonderful place where we look out for each other. With all of this help, I wish I could tell you that the need for Alpine's services has diminished.
